





Call for papers - EAWOP Small Group Meeting on Dark Personalities in Organisations

We are looking for **20 innovative presentations** of unpublished research to be submitted to the EAWOP SGM on *Dark Personalities in Organisations*. This research should address the Dark Triad/Tetrad traits collectively or individually, or other so-called dark personality traits (e.g., borderline personality, authoritarianism) in an organisational context. As a result of the SGM, we plan to propose a Special Issue to the *European Journal of Work and Organizational Psychology* (*EJWOP*). In addition to the academic focus, **2 workshops** will be held at the SGM and we are happy for any applications for one of these workshops:

- 1) A workshop led by an expert practitioner that covers the coaching and training field
- 2) A workshop led by a policymaker that covers the political field
